



SUMMER CHAMBER MUSIC EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Southern Ontario Chamber Music Institute (SOCMI) provides gifted string and piano students with an enriched, summertime learning experience. Our program offers an in-depth study of small ensemble chamber music under the direction of an internationally acclaimed faculty. Through a unique mentoring experience, you will learn the complexities of applying your individuality to the music – learning from your mentors and from each other. We welcome applications from both individuals and pre-formed ensembles.

Our 2011 one-week program provides individual lessons, ensemble coaching master classes, open rehearsals, and faculty and student concerts. Repertoire will be emailed in advance to ensure you are rehearsal-ready on arrival at the Institute. You will be informed of your ensemble members prior to commencement of the institute unless you are applying as a pre-formed ensemble.

The program takes place on the lakefront campus of **Appleby College in Oakville, Ontario** 40 km west of Toronto. Participants are housed in a dedicated residence with full access to a dining hall and facilities for rehearsals, performances and recreation.

Performances by faculty are integral to the learning experience and the program culminates in a **Student Showcase Concert** where your ensemble presents the work on which you've been coached and have rehearsed during your week together.
